## CIRCULAR

Subject: Filling up the post of Law Officer in the National Commission for Scheduled Castes by deputation (Including short-term contract/ absorption /re- employment of ex-Servicemen).

It is proposed to fill up of one post of Law Officer (General Central Service, Group 'A' Gazetted, Non Ministerial) in the Pay Band-3 of Rs. 15600-39100+6600 (GP) in the National Commission for Scheduled Castes by deputation (Including short-terms contract/ absorption /reemployment of ex-servicemen) initially for a period of one year likely to continue up to three years. The eligibility condition for selection by deputation (Including short-terms contract/ absorption /reemployment of ex-serviceman ) for the said post are given below:

Officers under the Central or State Governments or Union Territories or Universities/recognized Research Institutions or Public Sector Undertakings or Semi-Government or Statutory or autonomous organizations:-

(a) (i) Holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre / department; or

(iii) With five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in Pay Band-3 of Rs. 15600-39100 with Grade Pay of Rs. 5400/- or equivalent in

the parent cadre or Department; or

(iii) With six years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the Pay Band PB-2 in the Scale of Pay of Rs. 9300-34800 with Grade Pay of Rs.4800/-or equivalent in the parent cadre or Department; and possessing the educational qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits as given below:-

Master Degree in law of a recognized University / Institute or equivalent and possessing five years' teaching and / or research experience in law, Or Bachelor's degree in Law of a recognized University / Institute and possessing seven years teaching and / or research experience in law; Or Should have been a member of State Judicial Service for seven years or Should be a qualified legal practitioner, i.e. Advocate (within the meaning of advocates Act, 1961), who has practiced as such for seven years.

- **Note 1.** In computing the period during which a person has held an office in the State Judicial Service, there shall be included any period during which he has held any other legal posts or any period during which he has been a legal practitioner.
- Note 2. In computing the period during which a person has been qualified legal practitioner, there shall be included any period during which he has held any office in the State Judicial Service or has held a legal post in the department of the State or Central Government, Union Territory, Govt. Research Institute or other research institute of recognized universities

Note 3 Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission for reasons to be recorded in writing, in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 4 The qualification regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the UPSC for reasons to be recorded in writing. In case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, if at any stage of selection, the UPSC is of the opinion that sufficient number of
