NOTIFICATION

G.S.R.....In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Deputy Inspector-General of Police in the Commission for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement:-

- (1) These rules may be called the Commission for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Group 'A' post) Recruitment Rules, 1986.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and scale of pay:

The number of post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule hereto annexed.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications:

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 4 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification:-

No person, -

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,
- shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax:

Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with

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the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Provis :

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

PROMOTION/TRANSFER OR DEPUTATION

From:-

(1) Officers of the Indian Police Service who are holding regular posts on a regular basis or who are approved for appointment as Deputy Inspector-General of Police.

(ii) The departmental Superintendent of Police in the Commission for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes with 10 years regular service in the grade will also be considered and in case he is selected for appointment to the post, the same shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion.

(The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment shall not be exceed five years).
